

It has shown an increase with the level of education, with the highest participation rates found among those with post-secondary education. Over 60% of the total population ranging from 16–84 years participate at least twice a week. These notable changes may pave the way to inspire Indian sports development and help India in discovering its potential to be a target market for Swedish sports leagues

At the beginning of 2020, nobody would have imagined that a match, let alone tournaments in their entirety, will be held in empty stadiums and quiet atmospheres as the pandemic brought the sporting world to a standstill. Prior to the pandemic, we saw an 8% YoY growth in the sports sector in India, which is now predicted to grow at only 3.3% in the coming 3-5 years. Bridging this gap will increasingly require the state authorities to step in, as well as highlight the impact of sporting events and help grassroots programmes reach all communities.



In the year of 2020, online fantasy gaming has gained a strong foothold within the Indian entertainment Industry. Our country has a user base of 628 million gamer's which gives a massive boost to the gaming ecosystem within the Indian economy.
